2. The necessity of Darakbang (Field) Evangelism

- 1) It is the training God wants the most for lay people.
 - Matthew 28:16-20, Mark 3:13-15, Matthew 10:1-42
- 2) It is not service oriented but life centered. Acts 17:2-4
- 3) It is not simple Bible study but a platform for sharing.
- 4) It is the fundamental place for the saints' fellowship.
- 5) The committed workers must learn and practice the correct ministry.
- 6) It is the platform for continuous evangelism.
- 7) It is the place to experience the Holy Spirit's work and what He desires in the field.
- 8) It is the optimal place for nurturing.
- 9) It is a place of disciple training.

3. The content of Darakbang Evangelism

- 1) Bearing fruits through the continuous Word movement.
- 2) Placing emphasis on accepting Jesus (life).
- 3) Continuous content pertaining to salvation.
- 4) Coming to know service, morals, system, and devotion centered on salvation.
- 5) Holy Spirit movement
- 6) Power rather than knowledge

4. Methodological principles of Darakbang Evangelism

- 1) Unbelievers do not have any spiritual knowledge.
- 2) Thus, they cannot come to the way of salvation on their own. We must go and save them.
- 3) Many of the present believers are wandering.
- 4) Many of the committed workers are discouraged.
