3. Relayed to the Antioch

- 1) 30 : Having gathered the congregation together, they delivered the letter...
- 2) 33 : Judas and Silas returned...
- 3) 35 : Paul and Barnabas remained in Antioch...

4. The Start of the 2nd Evangelism Journey

- 1) 36 : Visit the brothers from every city...
 - (1) It is important to confirm and establish again.
 - (2) That time a different door will open.
 - (3) There is one thing that the ministers must never forget.
- 2) 39 : There arose a sharp disagreement... (Acts 13:13)
 - (1) The start of the difference of evangelism between Paul and Barnabas.
 - (2) It is a spiritual battle, so it is very important to check upon the spiritual state of the members.
 - (3) The start of Paul and Silas' team.
- 3) God showed that Paul was right.
 - (1) Spiritual eyes are important for the evangelists.
