A Thousand and Ten Thousand Times

2 Kings 13:14-25

God's proclamation is that all problems can be resolved through the Gospel. John 19:30 it is finished means that it is the covenant. When you enjoy the blessing of the throne inside the covenant, enjoying that power and authority is the promise of the bible. The bible contains many examples of people who enjoyed this mystery. This amazing Gospel must become yours and must appear in your field as well, and training is what allows this to take place. Through training the problem of Genesis 3 that still remains in you as well as certain aspects in your life that have yet become the complete Gospel can be healed. We are trying to begin the Immanuel Church of Southern California 237 training on Saturdays. This is the place where all the church officers, assistant pastors, remnants, and multi-ethnic people can gather together to pray, receive the Word, and become healed. You can take it as the time to pray for Immanuel Church of Southern California heading towards the 237 nations and the place to receive the Word. It is the time to go deeper into God's desire, the Gospel, and prayer. It is the time to plant the stream of the word and message into your life. This mission is not fundamental however, it is God's plan to carry out this fundamental covenant on this earth. Because God's will is unchanging it is called the absolute plan. May the blessing be upon you where this becomes your covenant once again.

1. A Thousand and Ten Thousand Times

- 1) Today's bible passage records a story that occurred during the death of Elisha. Joash, who was the grandson of Jehu, who used to clean King Ahab's house, was the king of Israel during this time. When King Joash went to Elisha who was dying, Elisha told him to take his bow and arrows. (17)
- 2) He said to shoot the arrow for the arrow represented the arrow of victory over Syria. He stated that it was the arrow of salvation that will shoot and destroy the king of Syria. He told him to take the bow and arrow and strike the ground with them. (18)
- 3) King Joash struck the ground three times and stopped. It states, "Then the man of God was angry with him and said, 'You should have struck five or six times; then you would have struck down Syria until you had made an end of it, but now you will strike down Syria only three times." (19)
- 4) This is today's bible passage. When I first heard of this story, I did not know what to do with it. I did not know what it meant for him to strike the ground, why the number of strikes matter, or why it had to be 5-6 times. I did not know what to do with this, and simply expected a prophet to explain this.
- 5) For about ten years, I was in this questionable state. Because I did not have the Gospel, my spiritual eyes were not opened, I always thought theoretically, and I could not escape the standard of my thoughts which revolved around me.
- 6) Eventually, I came to know the Gospel. I enjoyed, relayed, and experienced the Gospel as my spiritual eyes slowly began to open. Although I was still lacking, from time to time I would think about a few things from this bible passage.
- 7) Firstly, everything is only by God's grace, but King Joash was an idol worshiper and was not one that deeply enjoyed the Gospel. Through this deep spiritual communication, a man like David sat on the right hand of God and knew that Melchizedek was Christ, 1000 years before Christ came. (Psalms 110)
- 8) King Joash was very different. Therefore, there was a big difference in the way they were led by the Holy Spirit and this is what led to the unfortunate event of only striking the ground three times.

- 9) I wondered what would have happened if King Joash questioned, in the moment, what striking the ground meant. Then, Elisha could have explained it all and King Joash could have struck the ground the correct number of times.
- 10) If you think about it this way, then it could have been a historical moment that would have changed King Joash's life and the history of Israel and Aram. This means that the future of Israel and King Joash was decided by whether or not this thought was brought up. When you think about it, it is a spontaneous moment and it is a moment when you have no choice to make a confession because you can do nothing without God's grace.
- 11) Like this, it is so important that your thoughts are communicating with God. Today's bible passage shows that there is no choice but to come to the conclusion that this spiritual communication is everything in your life.
- 12) Then what must you do now? This is important for you. You still do not know how many times you must strike the ground. You do not know what it means to strike the ground and what would happen when you do strike the ground. However, you must strike the ground and it has a very close relationship to what occurs in your future.
- 13) So the phrase that you must remember is to strike the ground one thousand and ten thousand times. You must strike the ground for 24 hours and 365 days. During their time, their opponent was one nation, Aram, but you must do world evangelization now. It is the Americas, Latin America, and the 237 nations.
- 14) Your concept is the universe and the throne. You must surely strike the ground one thousand, ten thousand times. Then you will have victory one thousand and ten thousand times and will continuously be victorious. There is a message that states that if David fought against Goliath 100 times, he would be victorious 100 times.
- 15) It is such a definite thing. You must simply hold onto the covenant and strike the ground. You must do this for 24 hours in your life and this must be the main work that you do in your life. Then, your future will crush Satan and you will be victorious against the world.
- 16) You must simply go into the covenant. Then, it will become your bartizan and your strength. From this, you will see your future that conquers. This is your fundamental work and must be the main work in your life.
- 17) Within this, you must also do the detailed, physical work. The physical work that you do will become a miracle that occurs when you strike the ground once again. May you open your spiritual eyes and be upon the grace to receive blessings. This blessing is also inside of Christ.

2. The Spiritual Things

- 1) All things on this earth are decided upon by the spiritual things. Everything that is physical is captured within the spiritual things that are not visible to your eyes. Joash must have returned back to the kingdom to complete his duties. However, his future was decided upon the number of times he struck the ground.
- 2) At the very least, the problems of the nation, Aram, was like this. The king must protect the nation for if he fails to, then they would be destroyed by the enemy forces. At the time, Israel was continuously invaded by Aram and Aram became the biggest problem to the king of Israel.
- 3) In reality, it is impossible for a small nation like Israel to defeat Aram. Therefore, it was so important for King Joash to strike the ground. His entire life was dependent on this spiritual action.
- 4) Today's bible passage says that everything in your life is at stake in this spiritual matter that seems like nothing. Your future is at stake in this seemingly nothing spiritual act.

- 5) The most fundamental spiritual act is accepting Christ as the master of your life. The next part is to enjoy, serve, and give thanksgiving to God and Christ who is within you.
- 6) Also, it is to enter into the deep enjoyment of Christ, receive many answers, stand as a witness, and relay the Gospel to the world. When you have continuation you will have conquest and your spiritual eyes will be open to America, South America, and the universe. On top of that, your spiritual eyes will be opened to see the Throne. This is the most fundamental spiritual action that you must carry out.
- 7) The work that you must do is unchanging. Neither is it versatile. All you need to do is continue to do the same things and focus only on that. To be honest, nothing else is needed because everything will come from doing this alone. Like Joash, you may do physical work. However, that work is the process of planting the covenant in your life and future.
- 8) I hope that the miracle of striking the ground a thousand times will be upon all of you. I hope that you will all find a reason to do this and therefore continue without stopping. Then, of course, you will conquer the future and enjoy the blessings of the throne every day across the universe.
