The One who Knows the End

Sunday service

Matthew 28:16-20

Matthew 28:19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations." That's why the end of your life is for missions. The one who knows this end is the one who will conquer all things. This was the case for Moses, Apostle Paul, and the 7 Remnants. Today is that day that we observe World Missions Day. God has one desire which is to testify of this Gospel to the ends of the earth and to save those who have fallen into curses. For God there is nothing else that is more valuable than this work. Therefore, the one who gives their life to do this work will rightfully have victory and conquest. You are living in the mission field. In the past, the American missionaries testified to the Gospel. Now it is your turn to repay the grace that you have received to testify the Gospel in America. Knowing what America is to God is very important to your life. Knowing that God desired to do this work and living your life heading towards this work is very precious wisdom. You are the ones who have received the historical Gospel. Because the Gospel is God's standard for all things God will show you the historical evidence. As you pray, God will show you this work especially in America and South America and that it will be relayed to the ends of this earth. With this in mind, the World Mission Sunday is a very meaningful day.

1. The one who knows the end

- 1) The end of your life must be for missions. Those that know this end will conquer their life and the world. Moses knew the land of Canaan. He accepted it as the end and it became his personal covenant. He was never once shaken about going to the land of Canaan.
- 2) His heart was centered on conquering the wilderness. They lived in a place where people would not survive for 3 days for 40 years. They never starved, died of thirst, or sold their possessions to survive despite the fact that they did not harvest their own crops.
- 3) During the day, the pillar of cloud covered the scorching sunlight of the desert and during the night, the pillar of fire heated them up from the cold. This occurred every day for 40 years. They never lost in a battle and there were times when God led them to the area that had water in which water came out of a dry boulder.
- 4) God frequently gave them the Word, so they were led through the wilderness. This was because he knew the end and held onto this as his unchanging covenant. Despite the cries of His people who resisted their journey through the wilderness, God did not give up on this end, but rather chose to wait until they were all dead.
- 5) God was determined to not give up on this end to this extent. That end is equivalent to world evangelization of this age. Therefore, God will most definitely prepare a disciple to do this work like Moses. It was Joshua, Caleb, Prostitute Rahab, and the Remnants.
- 6) It was the same for Apostle Paul. Apostles Paul's lifelong covenant was world evangelization, Gentiles, and Rome and he staked his life on it. He knew it very well. He knew the end to where his life should head towards, He did not give up on the end that God revealed to him, and he knew that he should not yield to anything else for the sake of the Gospel. He never once shook regarding this matter.
- 7) Therefore, he staked his life in the midst of hardships and difficulties, but it was much joy to him. This is what he held to as he knew he'd receive the heavenly reward.
- 8) That is the reason why God has attached many disciples to him. There were the patrons that risked their necks to die, there were the hosts that gave all their inheritance for the Gospel movement, and fellow workers that will use their entire life for the sake of the ministry. They were the ones that risked their necks for it and they were attached to Paul because he knew the
- 9) They were centered on this through evangelism and it continued on for 200-300 years for Rome evangelization. Through that, the new doors of world evangelization were opened. Also, it raised the culture of Christianity.
- 10) You have been called for this historical work. Therefore, God will do the historical work through you. With the Gospel as the foundation, may you be the one that goes to the end.

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- 11) If you hold to the end inside the Gospel, then God will begin to work. Then, you will be the witness that will conquer all. If you are not shaken with this truth, then God will be at work. For that is God's only desire.
- 12) It is God's promise that will rightfully arise to those that enjoy Christ as their covenant. May you receive the blessing of opening these spiritual eyes.

2. Scheduled prayer

- 1) Scheduled prayer moves the world. Acts 3:1 "Now Peter and John were going up to the temple at the hour of prayer, the ninth hour." There was an uproar because of the miraculous work that arose in the gate of the temple called Beautiful Gate in Jerusalem.
- 2) He sat in front of the temple to which all the Israel men knew of him. Everyone was in an uproar because the news spread that the lame beggar arose after the name of Jesus Christ was proclaimed to him.
- 3) This is the message behind scheduled prayer. All things will arise and take place during the time of prayer. Daniel was the best person who was in scheduled prayer as he stood as the witness before Babylon. Daniel 6:10 "When Daniel knew that the document had been signed, he went to his house where he had windows in his upper chamber open toward Jerusalem. He got down on his knees three times a day and prayed and gave thanks before his God, as he had done previously."
- 4) Daniel was sent to the lion's den, but God saved him and changed the king's heart to send the officials who sent Daniel to the lion's den. Even when the kings changed four times, he remained as the governor because he was a person that resolved his heart in the Gospel and was in scheduled prayer.
- 5) Apostle Paul evangelized by praying. When the doors to testify the Gospel to Asia did not open, Apostle Paul prayed and he saw a vision to go to Macedonia.
- 6) The first region that he went to in Macedonia was Philippi. He did not go out to evangelize first, but prayed. He first prayed because he needed to seek out the prepared disciples from God. Acts 16:12 "We remained in this city for some days." It was a time for them to pray as they remained in the city. On the day they met Lydia, they did not go out to evangelize first, but seeked a place of prayer.
- 7) Acts 16:13 "Where we supposed there was a place of prayer." Through that, they met Lydia and the slave girl who had a spirit of divination. After he met Lydia, he should've gone out to evangelize, but he did not. Acts 16:16 "As we were going to the place of prayer." The place of prayer was already set for them because it states previously that they suppose there was a place of prayer, but they found the place of prayer to which they were going there.
- 8) At that time, he met the slave girl who had a spirit of divination. This was the work that arose through Apostle Paul. Romans 1:9 "That without ceasing I mention you." Before he went to Rome, he always prayed for the believers and evangelism in Rome. Before he did anything, he always prayed.
- 9) Apostle Paul evangelized through prayer. The evangelist's scheduled prayer is very important. The one who has the Gospel and enters into scheduled prayer is important.
- 10) Many covenantal words that define prayer through the messages such as continuous prayer, scheduled prayer that enjoys the covenant, the summit time of the covenantal prayer, 24hrs, 25hrs, eternity, deep prayer, concentrated prayer, and the prayer to raise the bartizan of God in yourself.
- 11) However, it is very important for you to set a personal time to pray. Everyone must have the thought to pray before God and put that into action. It's a matter of whether you do it or not.
- 12) God does not need a prayer that you do so well. God desires for your prayer to be sincere and earnest to which you can stand before God. May you place your heart and pray. You need the spiritual power to continuously pray. For you to go to the end is completed and finished in Jesus Christ.
- 13) There is power and authority for those who have the Gospel and pray. The power of the Gospel in prayer will be revealed to the world. Also, God will be at work in the time of prayer.

14) May you confirm the blessings that is contained in the power and authority that is promised in the Gospel was you pray. The end of your life mission. This is God's desire and the one who knows the end will have conquest upon their lives and the world. There is authority and blessings for those who are in Jesus Christ. May all blessings be upon you.
