Conquerors

2 Corinthians 4:1-10

Today, you are giving worship to God. You must hold to the covenant and give worship. It must be a time of worship of thanksgiving and glory to God. It must be a time of worship to bind Satan, for God's kingdom to be established, and for the heavenly armies to be mobilized in the fields. What you should keep in mind is the starting point. The covenant must be the starting point. From here, your life will receive God's complete support and enjoy the promises stated in the Bible. The Bible promised liberation from curses. Also, the Bible promises victory and conquest from curses from Original sin and Satan's authority. You must be the one to block the world's disasters and save them. May this time of worship be the time to receive answers and have the answer as your covenant. May it be a time of Only that you no longer wander, but go in the depths of the covenant.

1. Conquerors

- 1) The one who holds to God's covenant and stands before God will be raised as those who remain to testify the covenant and take the pilgrimage. Those who live the life of the pilgrims will conquer themselves, the world, and the age.
- 2) It is God's only desire for you to take the pilgrimage to testify the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Therefore, those who connected with God's desire and the covenant led the age.
- 3) You must live a life of holding to that goal. You must live the life to save America and South America and leave behind the masterpiece that will be passed on to the next generation. May the church be used to fulfill God's will in this age.
- 4) Through this, the church and you must be used to block the disasters of America and South America to save many people and churches. This is what the Apostle Paul did. He already came to the answer of the Gospel and God's desire. He was victorious and conquered everything.
- 5) 2 Corinthians 4:8 "We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair." Apostle Paul came to the answer to which he never stumbled amid persecution. He was in a state that was never influenced by the affairs that arose. No one was able to destroy the God-given leisure that was placed in his heart. During frustrating times, he was never discouraged because it was what he expected.
- 6) The 7 remnants came to the answer to which they were never taken aback when events arose. They correctly analyzed the problems that arose and knew the reason why they took place to which they were the state of being unbothered by the affairs that arose. That is why Apostle Paul was never discouraged by all the work that arose.
- 7) 2 Corinthians 4:9 "persecuted, but not forsaken." How many times was he persecuted? However, God was with Apostle Paul more than ever during those times. God comforted and encouraged Apostle Paul
- 8) 2 Corinthians 4:9 "struck down, but not destroyed." Apostle Paul was probably more excited than ever because great doors of evangelism opened, important disciples were attached, and answers of miracles appeared before him. It is because the work that Apostle Paul desired was God's desire.
- 9) Your life needs to be aligned with God's desire. This must the your life's covenantal journey. It is very meaningful and important to you. Therefore, 237 nations and 5,000 tribes are one of God's covenants for you.
- 10) You may live a life that is afflicted in every way, but not crushed in times of frustration. You may be persecuted, but not forsaken. Just like Apostle Paul, you must be victorious and live the life to conquer all things. Apostle Paul conquered everything. He was a sincere conqueror and a pilgrim who spiritually and physically conquered all things.

2. God's given mystery

1) How can you live the same life as Apostle Paul who was victorious and conquered all things? How can you live a life to change worldly politics, and the laws of society, and make a new culture? This is a question that you may ask.

- 2) 2 Corinthians 4:10 states what kind of person Apostle Paul was. 2 Corinthians 4:10 "Always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our bodies." The body of the death of Jesus signifies the crucifixion.
- 3) It is the body of the death of Jesus who shed his precious blood that has crushed the head of Satan and curses. Not only that, He demonstrated sacrifice, love, and suffering to you. He took the cross for you.
- 4) You must always live the life to deeply enjoy the covenant of the amazing sacrificial life He has given to you. You must never forget the death of Jesus Christ. You must always cherish it in your heart and live the life that is manifested in your life.
- 5) Then, you will live for the rest of your life to testify this covenant to the ends of the earth. How could Paul, a man of the covenant, be upset because he was being bothered by people, or discouraged because something frustrating happened to him?
- 6) Even though he was persecuted, he was not forsaken. He was struck down, but not destroyed. The one who has the covenant will never fail. Whatever happens, they will never crumble. They will be victorious and conquer everything. All the remnants including Joseph lived this life.
- 7) The answer for you today is the death of Jesus Christ. You must always carry in the body the death of Jesus. He has died for you instead, so you do not have to die for your sake. You will be just like the tree that is planted by the stream to which it yields its fruits in seasons and the leaf never withers. If the one who has the covenant placed in their heart, how can they be discouraged, afflicted, and struck down? That can never happen.
- 8) May you come to the answer of the Gospel. His death and bloodshed on the cross have set you free from curses and crushed the head of Satan. You have received the authority to break them with a rod of irons and dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel. Also, you will receive the authority of all possessions to the ends of the earth. The Bible states important evidence and examples.
- 9) 2 Corinthians 4:4 "In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God." The covenant that you hold will crush the heads of the demons that are at work. It may look like the blood of the lamb that is powerless, but there is nothing that can defeat the power of the blood. It destroys all.
- 10) May you deeply hold to the covenant and enjoy it as you follow God's desire to be victorious and live the life of conquest just like Apostle Paul. The answer is the promising blood of Jesus Christ.
