He Knows My Name

Psalm 91:1-16

To know God's name is to know God. Not just to know that His name is Jehovah but also to know that He is the one who made all things and is still running them according to His will and that He is the one who sent Christ to earth to save people from the curse. It is the same for you to pray in the name of Jesus Christ. He is the Christ and God. His death and shedding of blood are the only ways to deliver man from the curse, and covenantal blood is God's promise to crush Satan's head and break man's fate and destiny altogether. His blood is the perfect covenant by which we can be with God forever, the equivalent of a fish out of water to be in the water again forever. To know, believe, and hold on to Him is to pray in His name. Psalm 91:14 "Because he holds fast to me in love, I will deliver him, I will protect him, because he knows my name." Nothing in the world can destroy His name, which has all the authority. No one can overcome His name which has all authority. May you plant His name in your heart and give worship to God in the name of Jesus Christ who is your covenant.

1. He knows my name

- 1) Today's message title is from Psalm 91:14. If you know the name of God and know Christ in the way it is described, God will exalt and raise the bartizan in you, so that you can take this Gospel to the ends of the earth.
- 2) Today's Bible passage testifies concrete promises of God. Psalm 91:3 "For he will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence." Psalm 91:5-6 "You will not fear the terror of the night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor the destruction that wastes at noonday."
- 3) Psalm 91:7-8 "A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you. You will only look with your eyes and see the recompense of the wicked."
- 4) Psalm 91:9 states the condition to receive this blessing. Psalm 91:9 "Because you have made the LORD your dwelling place—the Most High, who is my refuge." This is the condition. Psalm 91:1 states it as well.
- 5) Psalm 91:9 "Because you have made the LORD your dwelling place—the Most High, who is my refuge." This is the condition of all the promises stated in the Bible passage. How can God be your dwelling place, the Most High, and your refuge? How can the Lord be in your dwelling place-the Most High, who is your refuge?
- 6) If this takes place then, the fulfillment of Psalm 91:3 "For he will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence" and Psalm 91:7-8 "A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you. You will only look with your eyes and see the recompense of the wicked." will be upon you.
- 7) This very important condition is contained in His covenant. If you are in His promising blood and sacrifice, then it will be done according to it.
- 8) God's blessings and authority are only contained in Jesus Christ. If you know and hold to His name, then God's promise will be upon you. This is simple for you to do. All you need to do is put into action, confess, and hold to the covenant, then His promise will be upon you.
- 9) Psalm 91:11 "For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways." Psalm 91:13 "You will tread on the lion and the adder; the young lion and the serpent you will trample underfoot." Luke 10:19 "Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you." 1 John 3:8 "The Son of God appeared to destroy the devil's work."
- 10) Psalm 91:15-16 "When he calls to me, I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue him and honor him. With long life, I will satisfy him and show him my salvation." The Lord has promised this to you.
- 11) Psalm 91:15 "I will answer him; I will rescue and honor him." Psalm 91:16 "With long life I will satisfy him." This is a precious condition and promise that is contained only in Jesus Christ.

- When you enjoy Jesus Christ, the Lord will dwell in your place, the Most High will be your refuge.
- 12) When you hold and enjoy the covenant of Jesus Christ, you will tread on the lion and the adder upon your life. The Bible testifies to many examples of figures who lived this life.
- 13) Moses was originally a man who knew Christ, the offspring of a woman, who received the words of the covenant from God on Mount Horeb and carried them out in Egypt and the wilderness. By applying the blood of the promise that was in the covenant, the people were freed from slavery and lived 40 years in the wilderness where it was impossible to survive for more than three days.
- 14) No one died of hunger, and no one died for lack of water. For Moses personally, God answered all his prayers, delivered him in times of trouble, made him righteous, gave him a long life, and made him content with his life. He sent an angel always in his path before him.
- 15) Joseph was sold into slavery, but in the end, he conquered Egypt and Pharoah had no choice but to listen to him. He was a man of God's covenant, and God was always with him in his tribulations, delivering him from every snare of those against him.
- 16) Daniel, who resolved before God, went into the lion's den under pretenses, but God sent an angel there, and all his enemies who wanted to kill him died instead. He saw God's reward for the wicked, and all of Babylon saw it.
- 17) What about us? Can our church be like this, and can we as individuals live like this? We are a church that is praying to save the ends of South America. What would happen if we didn't stop with 100 teams, but if we started 1,000 teams or 10,000 teams and went to the ends of South America and continued to make disciples and continue to equip the next generation in the church and on the field to carry on this work?
- 18) If not, can we live the same life that is stated in Psalm 91? If so, He will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence. Also, you will receive the promise that a thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.
- 19) If you confess the covenant of Jesus Christ who crushed the head of Satan and fight the spiritual battle, then you will live a life like Moses and Joseph.
- 20) Ephesians 6:12 "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places." Apostle Paul states that he will no longer regard anyone by flesh. Isn't it because your battle is spiritual?
- 21) Therefore, anyone who holds and knows the name of Jesus Christ as the answer will be exalted by God. God will mobilize the angels in the fields, and Satan's kingdom will be bound and will trample over lions and serpents. You will receive answers, He will save you from troubles and honor you.
- 22) He promised that you will live a long life and will satisfy you. He promised that He will show His salvation in you forever. May you live this life. May you never forget the covenantal blood of Jesus Christ and confess it, so you will receive the same answer forever upon your life that is stated in the Bible passage.
