## **Put On the New Self**

Sunday service

**Ephesians 4:17-24** 

Those who have the Gospel change and develop. God's will is to give you the Gospel, so every moment is always a turning point in life. If you deeply enjoy the Gospel and live with Christ as a covenant, God will manifest in your life what He promised in Christ. Eventually, everything will be set free from the curse, you will be a perfect witness, and the answers worth 100 and 1,000 years of masterpiece will be given to you. The fact that there are so many examples of this in the Bible must be a message that those who enjoy the Gospel will live a life like this. Because the answer is the blood of Christ, when you hold it as a covenant and live by it, the life of God begins, and those who enjoy the secret will see the power and witness the work of God. May you be blessed to discover that this work life is promised in Christ.

## 1. Put on the new self

- 1) Ephesians 4:24 "And to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness." Put on the new man, which is created in holiness of righteousness and truth. Righteousness refers to the blood of Christ, His word, and all His actions. Truth is who He is, and all His words and teachings are the truth.
- 2) In the end, to become a new self is to be created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness. The Bible passage has a lot of very specific and practical things about your new self. It's a message that should be living and active in your life.
- 3) It has been said that the purpose of the Gospel is the law. The law is an elementary study for the Gospel, but it is also where the Gospel must go. The gospel goes beyond the law but rather embraces, revives, and fulfills it. Jesus said he came for this (Matthew 5:17-18).
- 4) May you be those who have forgiven all and forsaken all evil and have transcended everything else in the world. May you be the one who can say what Apostle Paul said and the answer is always the Gospel. He was a man of the Gospel, and he appreciated and enjoyed the Gospel.
- 5) To those who enjoy the Gospel, God gives them spiritual authority. The power of Hades shall not prevail against you. The offspring of the woman will crush the serpent's head. He has given you authority over demons. And the authority has been given to you to trample on serpents and scorpions. He has given you power over all the power of the enemy. These are important words that have been given to you.
- 6) All these promises are in the blood of Christ. Your inability to keep what is written in the Bible verses is a spiritual problem; therefore, you cannot keep these provisions except by the authority that is in the blood of Christ. Enjoying the Gospel is the only way to be victorious in peace and thanksgiving. The Apostle Paul was a man of 24. May this blessing be upon you as well.

## 2. The life that knows and goes in advance

- 1) Apostle Paul was a man of 24 in the Gospel, and therefore he showed himself to be much different from the others, even in his behavior and thoughts. None of the Apostles used words like these.
- 2) But to put it more precisely, Paul didn't get to this point by hard work; he got to this point by enjoying the power to crush Satan's head; to that extent, he was a man of the Gospel and was important to God. The covenant he received was the covenant of the age and God's plan for the whole world.
- 3) Anyone who has been given such a great plan must have been made a man of the Gospel to do such a thing. God has no other standard than the Gospel, so the degree to which a person is a man of the Gospel determines everything in his life.

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- 4) And so Apostle Paul, with this marvelous Gospel, went deep into God's plan for the age and probably went deeper and deeper into it as the years went on, to the point where he would go to experience the third heaven in deep prayer.
- 5) When God's word comes in, it first becomes your mission. After a few more years, it becomes a covenant that becomes the reason for living and an authority over all that you do. And with that covenant, after a few more years, it becomes a promise from God for your future, and with a few more years, it becomes a prophecy for your future.
- 6) And when you start to have the assurance that it's going to be fulfilled, you start to see the future, you start to say things like, "I know the future," and that's why Apostle Paul lived his life knowing where he was going. A person who has this kind of assurance and covenant is not swayed by the winds of the world, by what people say, or by what's going on in the world at the time.
- 7) Paul wasn't the only one, Moses, Joseph, David, Daniel, Elijah, Elisha, and countless others were, and you should all be like them. You should be like them and come to know their behaviors and attitudes.
- 8) He will not sin when he is angry, but he will give it all to God before the sun goes down, and he will lay it all down and forgive. One example is this: a person who has God's covenant will have a turning point in their life that will last so that in the end, it will be a work of receiving answers worth 100 and 1,000 years. May this blessing be upon you.
